Kevin Cilliers is currently the Technical Manager at the NCPC-SA. He joined the NCPC-SA at its inception in 2003 as a part time Junior Technical Specialist. His primary function between 2003 & 2005 was to assist the NCPC-SA to develop internal capacity and knowledge of Cleaner Production within in the Centre, to enable the NCPC-SA to go out and fulfil its mandate of RECP Awareness and Advocacy within SA Industry.

In 2005 Kevin was seconded full time from the CSIR's Materials Science & Manufacturing Unit to the NCPC-SA, and primed with the newly acquired CP knowledge was appointed as Project Manager to head activities within the Chemical Sector. Using his Chemical Engineering background and RECP knowledge Kevin pioneered assessments within the Centre with the support of UNIDO sponsored technical experts. To date Kevin has undertaken or been directly involved in over 100 RECP assessments in SME's and some large organisations. He has facilitated various training and awareness workshops aimed at promoting RECP within industry and the consulting services fraternity.

This experience has provided him with a sound technical base which in early 2012 resulted in him being appointed as Technical Manager at the NCPC-SA, a role he is currently fulfilling today.
